The October meeting will not (repeat NOT) feature our annual auction. I have ordered some more 10% fuel (3% castor, 17% synthetic) and hope to have it by meeting night. We are just about out of the 10% from the last order.

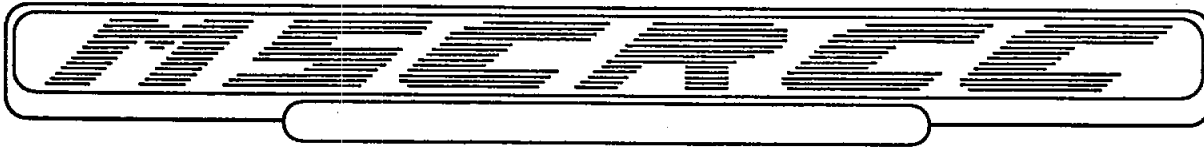
AUCTION NOTICE

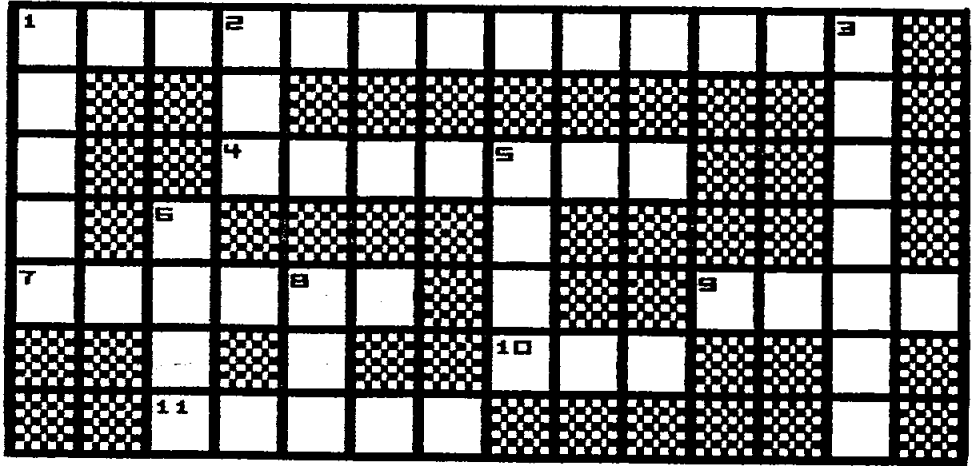

Note to Students:

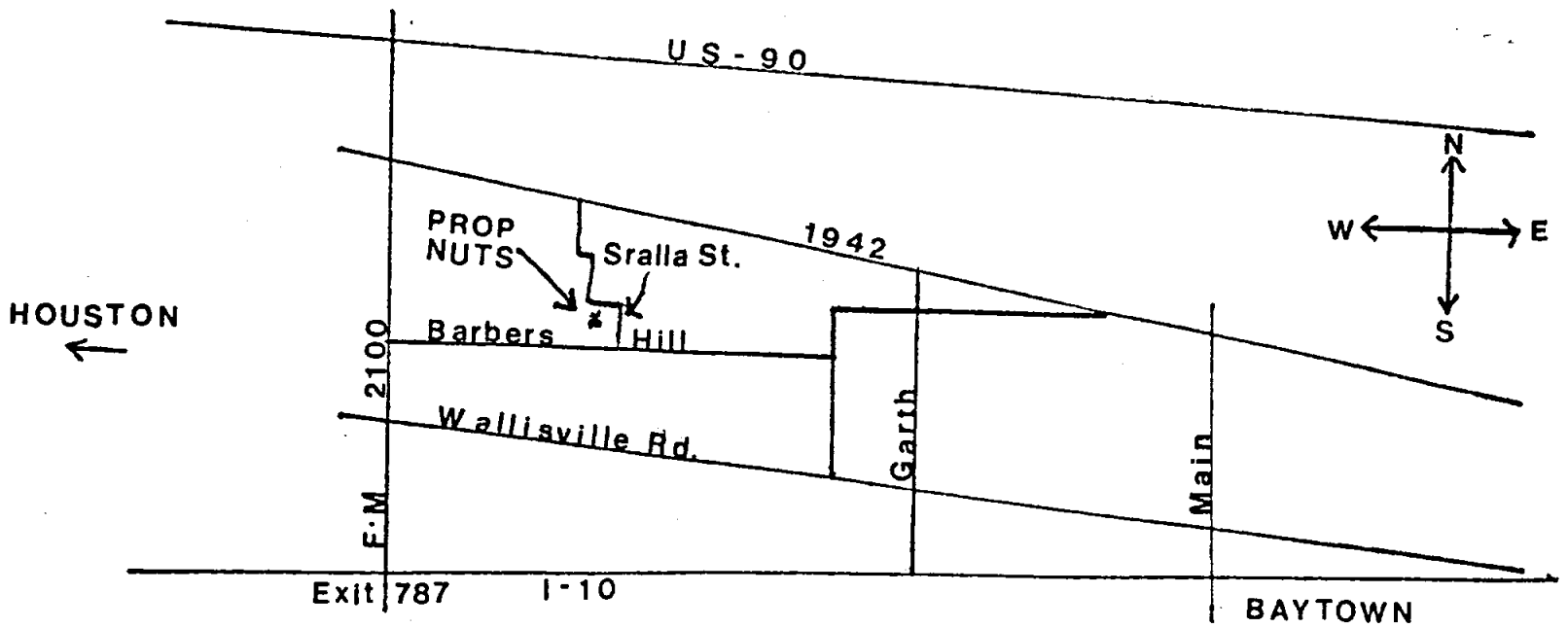

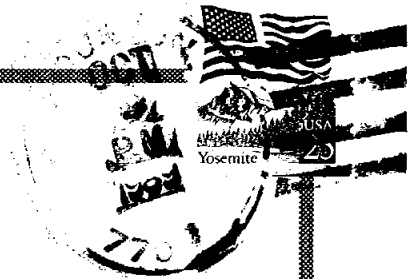

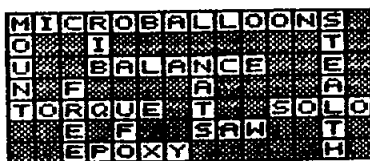
