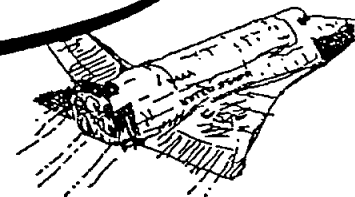

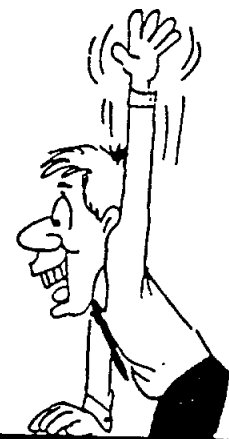

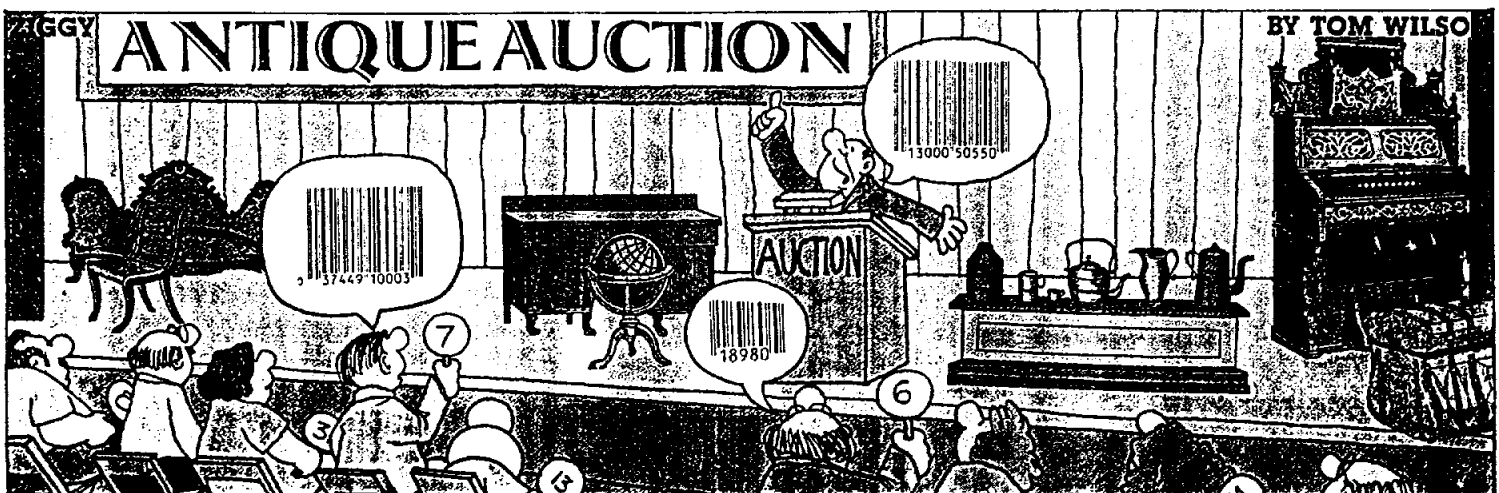
Model of the Month

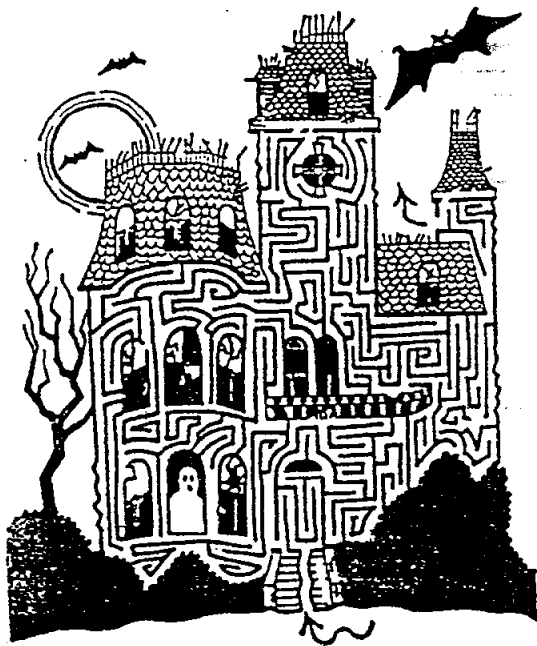

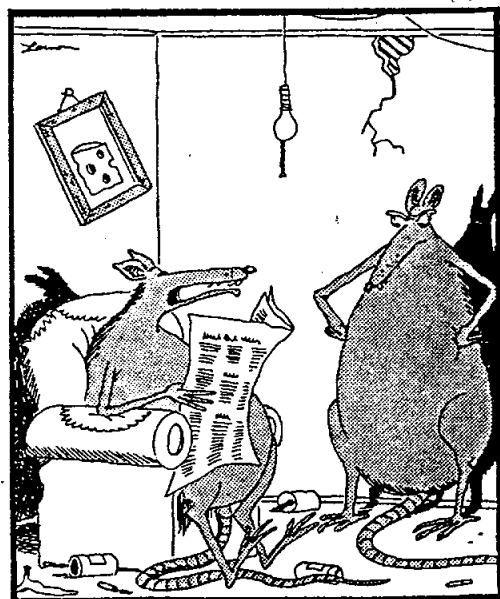
