

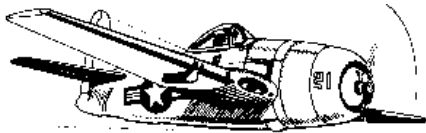

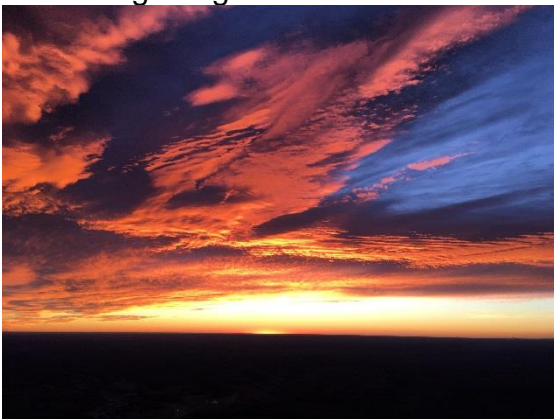
IN THE PITS
